

## D.C. COURT OF APPEALS

The District of Columbia Court of Appeals has a case numbering system in which part of a case number is a two-letter case-type identifier. Thus the appeal number identifies the type or source of the appeal.

The case type codes are as follows:

AA	Administrative Agency/Contested Cases
BG	Bar Governance (Admissions, Disciplinary, Unauthorized Practice)
BS	Bar Governance/Sealed Cases
CF	Criminal/Felony (Direct Appeal)
CM	Criminal/Misdemeanor (Direct Appeal)
CO	Criminal/Other
CT	Criminal/Traffic & Other DC Cases
CV	Civil
DA	Discretionary Applications
FM	Family Matters (including Domestic Relations, Mental Health and Retardation; Support; Custody)
FS	Family/Sealed (Juvenile; Neglect; Adoption; Paternity)
OA	Original actions (mandamus; prohibition)
PR	Probate
SP	Special Proceedings (e.g., Habeas Appeals; Certified Questions)
SS	Special Proceedings/Sealed
TX	Tax
