ORDER AND NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULEMAKING (Rule 46 (b)(8)(v))
(FILED - May 1, 2015)

The court having determined, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2071(e), that there is an immediate need to amend Rule 46 (b)(8)(v) of the Rules of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that D.C. App. R. 46 (b)(8)(v), which addresses the procedures for administering the bar exam, is amended, effective immediately, to provide as follows:

(v) Examination booklets shall be furnished by the Committee. Computers or typewriters furnished by the applicants may be used by prearrangement with the Director.

This amendment will give the Director of Admissions authority to permit the prearranged use of computers to take the bar exam. This NOTICE is published to afford interested parties an opportunity to submit written comments concerning this amendment and whether it should remain a part of the Rules of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals.
